The West Basin Municipal Water District (West Basin) Recycled Water Fill Station Program is available to all West Basin customers. You are allowed up to 300 gallons of recycled water per visit, free of charge.

There are important rules to follow and precautions to take. Your signature on this Agreement indicates your understanding of, and agreement to comply with, all conditions stipulated here.

Conditions For Recycled Water Use

- Do not drink recycled water.
- Recycled water may only be used at your service address to irrigate trees, turf, gardens, and other outdoor plants.
- Recycled water may only be stored in containers used at the fill station labeled with DO NOT DRINK stickers provided.
- Seal all containers with lids and secure for safe transport.
- Apply recycled water using gravity. Do not pump or put recycled water into onsite irrigation systems.
- Wash any fruit, vegetables or other edible plants that have been irrigated with recycled water with drinking water prior to cooking or eating.
- Do not allow recycled water to pond or puddle.
- Do not allow recycled water to run off the property by over-irrigating.
- Do not use the same equipment on both recycled water and drinking water systems (for example, quick couplers, hoses, tools, etc.).
- Do not use recycled water for filling swimming pools or spas.
- Do not use recycled water to wash hands or any other part of the body.
- Do not use recycled water for food preparation or clean-up.
- Do not allow recycled water to come into contact with drinking fountains or eating areas.
- Do not introduce recycled water into your household plumbing system.
- Do not cross-connect dissimilar water systems (for example, recycled to drinking water or vice versa).
- West Basin may conduct site visits to ensure your proper use of recycled water.

Certification Statement, Indemnity And Signature

This Agreement shall become effective upon my execution of this Agreement and shall terminate one year thereafter or, if earlier, at the end of the Recycled Water Fill Station Program. West Basin may terminate this Agreement sooner if I fail to comply with the conditions of this Agreement or West Basin's requirements for recycled water. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California without regard to conflict of law principles. All litigation arising

out of or relating to this Agreement shall be brought in the County of Los Angeles.
By checking this box, I certify I have read and understand all conditions in this Agreement and in the form entitled, "What to Know About the Use of Recycled Water at Home," which is incorporated herein, and agree to comply with these conditions and to conform to all requirements for recycled water use. Further, I understand that my failure to comply with the conditions of this Agreement may lead West Basin to bar me from participating in the Recycled Water Fill Station Program. I authorize West Basin to perform inspections as needed to ensure proper use of recycled water and to ensure the health and safety of my household and the public.
By checking this box, I hereby agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless, West Basin, its departments and divisions, including, without limitation, all of West Basin's boards, officers, employees, agents, representatives and assigns (Indemnitees) and, at the option of West Basin, defend the Indemnitees from and against any and all suits, causes of action, claims, charges, damages, demands, judgments, fines, penalties or losses of any kind or nature whatsoever (collectively, Claims) for death, bodily injury or personal injury to any person, or damage or destruction to my property or any property of Indemnitees or any third person, in any manner arising by reason of my participation in the Recycled Water Fill Station Program. Claims shall include any harm caused or incurred by my picking up or transporting recycled water, the use of recycled water or contact with recycled water, whether the harm occurs to me, my officers, agents, employees, invitees or patrons or to third parties, regardless of their status on the property, and regardless of whether I knew of, or in the exercise of due diligence, could have known or foreseen the likelihood of the particular harm. The foregoing release, hold harmless, and indemnity shall not apply to Claims arising or resulting from the sole negligence or the willful misconduct of West Basin, its departments, or its divisions. This paragraph shall survive expiration or termination of this Agreement.
