West Basin Municipal Water District is constructing a new recycled water pipeline that will expand recycled water use in the City of Torrance and deliver the first drop of recycled water to the Palos Verdes Peninsula.

What to Expect

Installation of the 3.5-mile recycled water pipeline is now complete, and a booster pump station at Lago Seco Park in Torrance is nearing completion. As part of the final construction activities, the parking lot at Lago Seco Park will undergo slurry seal treatment and restriping. This activity will require a temporary closure of the parking lot.

Slurry seal is a protective mixture of liquid asphalt and sand that helps extend the life of pavement and improves its appearance.

Temporary Parking Lot Closures & Access

To ensure proper application and drying, the parking lot will be closed to the public during the following dates:

- Monday, June 2, 2025 – Slurry seal treatment
Reopens on Tuesday, June 3, 2025
- Tuesday, June 10, 2025 – Restriping
Reopens on Wednesday, June 11, 2025

Temporary “No Parking” signs will be posted at least 72 hours in advance of both closures. Please ensure vehicles are not parked in the lot during the posted times, as vehicles may be towed at the owner’s expense.
